The winner will receive a monetary prize award of CHF 10.000 – together with a Certificate of Award.

When planning **your trip**, just remember that...

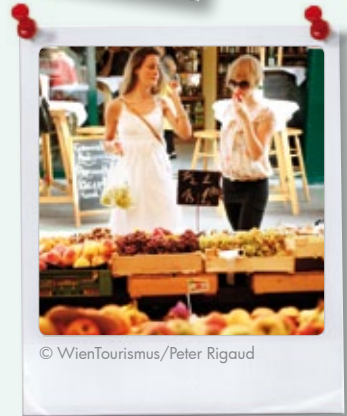
- travel to, from and within Vienna is quick and easy.

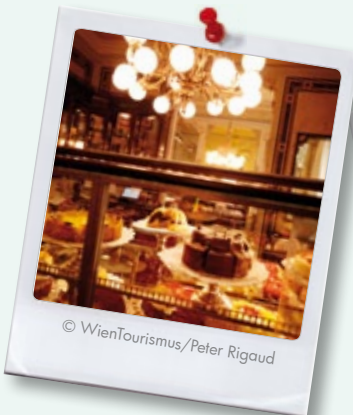
